

DBS now online!

The ECB have commissioned Atlantic Data to provide the Disclosures & Barring System (DBS) online vetting check system to the cricketing community. This system went live week commencing 16th October 2017.

The system is easy to use and provides a transparent DBS application process, enabling clubs to complete DBS applications far quicker than before.

If you are an existing document checker/verifier under the old paper system, the ECB will have sent you an email to register as an online verifier.

As a verifier using the online system you can initiate an application, complete verification and track the application's progress. The system also has step-by-step video tutorials giving guidance to support you.

If you haven't already, please ensure that you have registered with the ECB DBS unit if you wish to continue as a verifier. If you are having problems with this or wish to become a verifier and support your club please contact our County Welfare Officer Julie Rafferty or your local Development and Coaching Officer.

In addition, volunteers in cricket looking to complete or renew a DBS should contact a document checker/verifier, who will initiate the process for them; an updated list of document checkers/verifiers will be available on the Cheshire Cricket Board website soon.
