



Safe Hands and safeguarding training for Club Welfare Officers Proposed interim measures

Safe Hands workshops for new and existing Club Welfare officers have always been delivered face to face and should be renewed every 3 years. In view of the Coronavirus pandemic, all face to face workshops have been postponed until further notice.

In the meantime, the ECB Safeguarding Unit have been exploring the possibility of delivering and completing Safe Hands and safeguarding training in a different way.

ECB Safeguarding are:

- a) Making the Safeguarding Young Cricketers (SYC) online safeguarding course available for all CWO's who haven't completed a basic safeguarding workshop
- b) In the process of writing Safe Hands webinars for existing and new CWO's which will be run centrally. This will be a stop gap for the 2020 season and will only be valid for 12 months.
