

Guidance for Cricket First Aid

Please see a list of FAQs for the Cricket First Aid courses for season 2021.

What is the learner ratio?	The ratio is a maximum of 12:1. This has reduced to allow for better social distancing
What is the PPE requirement on course?	You are required to wear a face mask whilst on the course. These will be supplied if you do not have one.
What other PPE is required?	Due to no other contact with learners no other PPE is necessary (unless individual learners require it). There will be gloves and aprons available should anyone wish to use these.
What do I do if I feel ill prior to attending?	Please do not attend if you have any signs or symptoms. We can accommodate a further course if required.
What if I feel ill during the course?	Inform the tutor and you will be required to leave the course and follow medical advice.
What social distancing is required during the course?	Where possible the 2m social distancing guidance should be adhered to.
Has anything changed in First Aid due to Covid?	Yes – there is advice issued and this will be communicated on course.
What about the equipment we use on the course?	All equipment will be cleaned thoroughly. Any parts that can be replaced will be and certain restrictions will be communicated on course.
What about ventilation at the facility?	We will keep doors and windows open as much as possible therefore we encourage learners to dress appropriately.
