COVID –19 GUIDANCE FAQs FOR ENGLAND

As we move to step 4 (19th July) can players apply sweat and saliva to the ball?

We know we have a responsibility to ensure cricket remains safe and enjoyable for all. Therefore, the ECB strongly recommend participants should not apply sweat and/or saliva on the ball as this poses a greater risk of transmission. We encourage participants and clubs to promote good hygiene and continue to utilise hand sanitisers where appropriate.

Can clubs use their changing rooms from 19th July?

Changing rooms can be used where clubs are ready to make these available safely. However, clubs may wish to reduce the use of changing rooms due to the increased risk of transmission within enclosed indoor settings. No participants = No game, particularly if your team are asked to self-isolate.
