National Women's Club T20 Knockout Cup & Plate Competition 2022

Following the success of last year's competition I am delighted to be able to provide the details for next season. This is an open age competition which starts in May during the women's county T20 season and is an opportunity for all club cricketers to enjoy a national competition alongside their club league programme. However, if clubs are short of players we are encouraging local clubs to join together with up to 4 guest players being allowed.

The entry for next season's competition is either via the attached email entry form to sue.laister@ecb.co.uk or competitions@ecb.co.uk

The deadline for all entries is Friday 28th January 2022.

The draw will be released by Friday 4th February and will be split regionally & as a result some regions may be required to play more rounds than others (depending on the number of teams in each region). If preliminary rounds are required these will be on Sunday 24th April for the Cup & Sunday 15th May for the Plate. All first-round losers in the Cup competition will go forward to the Plate Competition to join those clubs who directly entered the Plate Competition, both competitions will be run on a similar basis.

The first named team in each round, up to the regional group final, will host the match, the second named team will be away. For the national semi-finals and national finals day the ECB will source a neutral venue, both the cup and plate finals will be played on the same day at the same venue.

Matches should be played on the set fixture date (as outlined below). However, if both teams agree to an alternative date (earlier or later than the set date) the match date may be amended providing that it is **no later** than one week before the next round of the competition. Clubs are advised that in considering alternative dates weekday evening matches are permissible. For the avoidance of doubt the national semi-finals and national final are to be played on the set dates below.

Clubs will be required to meet the costs of umpires until the regional group finals, ECB will appoint & assume this responsibility from this point. The home club should contact their County ACO to arrange umpires or may use a qualified club umpire. The ECB will provide Pink Tiflex balls for all rounds of the competition.
