Cheshire Cricket Board is seeking expressions of interest for an Independent Non-Executive Director with responsibility for Women & Girls Cricket across Cheshire.

This voluntary role will be effective from February 2023

Key Responsibilities

- Work in partnership with the Director of Cricket and his team, and the Cheshire Women's Cricket League to support, develop and promote opportunities for the successful delivery of female cricket across Cheshire
- Champion all aspects of female cricket across Cheshire, challenging those that hinder progress
- Share knowledge and expertise, providing guidance and support to those that seek it
- Liaise with relevant cricket networks and other organisations to learn from best practice
- Ensure the Board is informed of issues and challenges facing the female game and propose workable solutions
- Support the Board and promote its purpose, values, and collective views

Required Skills/Competences

- Sound knowledge of cricket and/or other female sporting activities
- Effective Communicator with the ability to challenge perceptions
- Ability to negotiate and influence decision making
- Ability to motivate and inspire others through creative thinking
- An awareness of ECB Policies, including Safe Hands and the ECB Equity Policy

The successful applicant should:

- Be legally able to act as a director
- Preferably be independent from the Cheshire Clubs Cricket Committee, the Cheshire Youth Cricket, and the Cheshire County Cricket Club Committee
- Be available to attend quarterly Board meetings
- Be available to hold office for a minimum period of two years
