Purpose & Experience:

Reporting to the Junior Coordinator (Phil Julier), the Cricket Coach is responsible for planning and delivering our U15 Cricket Training. Our coach would work in collaboration with the U15 Team Manager (Phil Julier) whose role is around team organisation and match days in the DCCL.

The U15 Cricket Coach is responsible for coaching and looking after a group of up to 15 children, delivering high energy, fun and inclusive sessions to ensure every child is engaged and makes progress, regardless of their ability. Activities can include anything from batting, bowling, wicket keeping and fielding, resulting in midweek match to demonstrate skills learned.

- Winter cricket nets: Four sessions on Tuesday 14th & 28th Feb and 14th & 28th April @ 6:30 for 2 hours. (Stockport Grammar School).

- Adhere to the HLCC Code of Conduct at all times.
- Liaison with U15 team manager and parents regarding feedback on players performance.
