## WK 2 STANDOUT STATS

Although there were a total of eight 1st XI fixtures cancelled, the first full week of action saw the new win/lose regulations come into effect, with the 'strict wide' interpretation making its mark! The 1st XI Divisional overview reads as follows: Prem = 130 wides (5 games); Div 1 = 57 wides (2 games); Div 2 = 116 wides (5 games); Div 3 = 164 wides (5 games), giving a grand total of 467 wides! Plenty of exercise for the umpires and additional work for the scorers!

In the Premier Division, newly promoted Bowdon lost heavily at Didsbury, whose 267-7 was the highest total of the day, whilst there were wins for Nantwich, Hyde, Chester BH and Grappenhall.

There was a hat-trick for Cheadle's Ben Broadhurst in a decimated Div 1 at Brooklands, but his final return of 9-1-37-6 was outdone by the canny Rob Leach, whose superb 9.1-5-15-7 helped his side to a 45 run win, despite defending just 92. There were six first-ball dismissals in that fixture, and overall in 1st XI matches, 14 batsmen had the miserable experience of an opening day golden duck - 51 batsmen in total made ducks of varying lengths. In the only other Div 1 game Marple just did enough to squeeze past Macclesfield by 3 runs.

No centurions in 1st XI cricket, although in Div 2 Alvanley's Michael Rowlands almost made it, finishing 98\* as his side overcame Congleton by 49 runs in a meeting of last season's relegated sides. Curiously there was also a meeting of the two promoted sides, Maritime's Sawan Kankanange making 98 as his side beat Ashley by 16 runs in a tight game, Ammad Mushtaq picking up where he left off last year, hitting 90.

Game of the day in Div 3 saw Christleton claim early bragging rights over neighbours Tattenhall but only just, their 9 run win a real nail-biter.

Of note in the 2nd XI cricket that was played, Timperley's Callum Yates returned figures of 13-4-11-7 and then hit 56\* (batting at 9) as his side won a Div 1 thriller by 1 wkt against Marple, while in Div 3, CBH's Marius Mostert made the only ton of the opening day, his 110\* helping his side comfortably beat Oakmere. In the same division Barrow beat Tattenhall by 40 runs despite conceding 68 extras! 34 wides and 29 no-balls were the main contributors.
