





Important update for all Cricket volunteers! Changes to ECB DBS Update Service

- The Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) has initiated a change in the process for volunteers seeking to renew or update their DBS certification. This is affecting <u>all volunteers across the country</u>, not only those in cricket.
- As a result of this change, to renew their certification, all volunteers must respond
 to the correspondence received from the ECB as well as log into their Disclosure
 Service account and manually renew on an annual basis. This has been instigated
 by the Disclosure & Barring Service (DBS) as they have modified its user agreement.
- We have attempted to summarise the new process below. If a volunteer does not follow the steps outlined, then their account will lapse, resulting in a failed checked by the ECB and a new full DBS application will need to be completed!

Do you know when your ECB DBS expires?

If not, find out from your Club/ Board DBS verifier(s)

You will receive <u>2</u> emails <u>30 days prior to the renewal date</u> from the ECB and DBS
