Legal basis for processing your personal data	 The legal basis for the collection and processing of your personal data is: administration: that it is necessary to fulfil the contract that you are going to enter or have entered into with us. for dealing with medical needs such as allergies: that you have given your explicit consent in all other cases: that it is necessary for our legitimate interests which are to regulate and to encourage participation in the sport of cricket and ensure, that the reputation of cricket is preserved, and this does not prejudice or harm your (or parents / guardians of children's) rights and freedom.
Your right to withdraw consent	Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it.
Location of your personal data	We will keep your personal data within the European Economic Area.
How long we will keep your personal data for	We will not retain your personal data for longer than is reasonable and necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. We shall retain your personal data for such time as you are involved with CCB / ECB / Partner programmes. 2 years after you cease to be involved or play an active part in CCB / ECB / partner programmes we shall delete your data.
Your rights in respect of your personal data	You have the right of access to your personal data and, in some cases, to require us to restrict, erase or rectify it or to object to our processing it, and the right of data portability.
