- Produce reports that help clubs plan, prioritise and improve their playing surfaces
- Offer guidance and advice to volunteer and professional ground staff
- Respond to requests for support where pitch quality concerns are identified
- Work in line with Cheshire Cricket Board, ECB and GMA policies and frameworks
- Act as an ambassador for good grounds management across Cheshire cricket

You will have:

- Practical experience in cricket pitch or sports turf maintenance
