CHILDREN'S COACHING COURSES

- The Parent/Guardian agrees to the child participating in the chosen course and understands that Cheshire Cricket Board Limited has a third party policy which provides cover for the child against loss/injury to him/her occurring as a result of negligence by the Cheshire Cricket Board Limited, its servants or agents. The parent/guardian may take out their own additional cover if they so wish.
- The Parent/Guardian confirms that the child will comply with the Age Group Players' Code of Conduct
- The Parent/Guardian understands the spirit of the Parents & Carers Code of Conduct
- The Parent/Guardian consents to the use of photography in the coaching and publicity of cricket which may take place involving the child.
- In the event of any injury or illness, all reasonable steps will be taken to contact the Parent/Guardian and to deal appropriately with that injury/illness.
- The Parent/Guardian acknowledges that it is their responsibility to inform the coach of any known illness/allergy a child may have.
- The Parent/Guardian acknowledges that their safety is their responsibility when attending indoor/outdoor courses.
- In the event of any misbehaviour during a Course, Cheshire Cricket Board Limited reserves the right to preclude anyone from that Course, and to refuse applications for future Courses. In such circumstances a refund may not be made.
- The Cheshire Cricket Board Limited reserves the right to cancel or amend any course.
- The Cheshire Cricket Board Limited will hold the details of attendees to maintain records and to provide and administer the goods and services requested from us.
- Requests for an Assisted Place on the Children's Courses at half the published price for those parents/guardian's in receipt of certain State Benefits should be addressed to the Cheshire Cricket Board's Offices 01606-871200.

REFUND POLICY

- The Cheshire Cricket Board operates a **strict no-refunds policy** for all bookings, programmes, courses, festivals, camps, and junior cricket activities.
- Refunds will **only** be considered in **exceptional circumstances**, defined as extreme, unforeseen, or welfare-related events that significantly prevent a participant from attending. Examples may include serious illness, family emergencies, or other situations that fall outside normal expectations.
- Any request for consideration must be submitted **in writing**, accompanied by relevant supporting information. The Cheshire Cricket Board reserves the right to determine whether the circumstances meet the threshold for exceptional consideration. All decisions are final.
- For junior cricket programmes, all refund requests will be reviewed with appropriate sensitivity and in line with the Board's **safeguarding and duty-of-care commitments**, ensuring the wellbeing of children and young people remains central to decision-making.
- By submitting payment or completing a booking, parents/guardians and participants confirm acceptance of this Refunds clause as part of the wider Terms & Conditions.

The Applicant may take out his/her own additional cover if they so wish.
- The Applicant confirms that he/she will comply with all Course requirements.
- The Applicant consents to the use of photography in the coaching and publicity of cricket which may take place during the Course.
- In the event of any injury or illness, the Applicant will advise the Course Leader of his/her inability to attend.
- The Applicant acknowledges that it is their responsibility to inform the Course Leader of any known illness/allergy they may have.
- In the event of any misbehaviour during a Course, Cheshire Cricket Board Limited reserves the right to preclude anyone from that Course, and to refuse applications for future Courses. In such circumstances a refund may not be made.
- The Cheshire Cricket Board Limited reserves the right to cancel or amend any course.
- If the Applicant is unable to attend one of the set modules, it will be his/her responsibility to arrange to attend an alternative, where possible.
- If the Applicant is unable to attend an Assessment on the scheduled date, Cheshire Cricket Board Limited will endeavour to arrange an alternative. In this event the Applicant will be charged an additional fee.

REFUND POLICY

- In the event of a Course being overbooked every attempt will be made to arrange a suitable alternative venue, or alternatively a refund will be made.

- Whilst all Courses are open to applications from Members and Non Members, priority will be given to Members where Course numbers need to be restricted. In this event a full refund will be made to Non Members.
Note: A Member is defined as a person being a fully paid up member of a Cheshire Affiliated Cricket Club, or a Teacher at a Cheshire School.
- Requests for refunds for reasons other than 1 & 2 above may be subject to a £10 deduction towards administrative costs.
